LAWRENCE ADAMS, MD ANATOMIC & CLINICAL PATHOLOGY

Dr. Adams is board certified in anatomic and clinical pathology. He joined Incyte Diagnostics in 2018 when Incyte acquired Blue Mountain Pathology, Inc. in Pendleton, Oregon.
